- **Old Business**
 - Review of Rise & Shine Meeting
 - Communication improvements
 - Michael reported on his attendance at the EPTAHP (Eatonton Putnam Tourism Arts Heritage Partnership) meeting. Very positive experience with representatives from departments/boards/authorities though out Eatonton/Putnam.
 - This group meets monthly on the 3rd Wed morning of each month. Representatives from BOE, DDA, City Council, County Commissioners, Main Street, PDA, Writers Museum, Eatonton Messenger, GA Power, etc. They share what their group is working on and collaborate on improving our community. Referred to as "The Think Tank."
 - Maggie Milner (Chamber of Commerce) is President of EPTAHP & Matt Pointer (Pres of PDA) is VP of EPTAHP.
 - Michael offered to give a report to the Main Street board after these meetings. If he is not able to attend the EPTAHP meeting, it would be beneficial for someone else on the Main Street board to represent us at that meeting and report back.
 - Hype Team
 - Still up in the air and still need name recommendations.

- **New Business**

- Where is the love?
 - Lauren visited downtown August with the mayor, Janie Reid, Maggie Milner, & Kevin Thompson Hooper (owner of Barrell 118 & Artisans Village) to view their downtown public art. Residences had been photographed and posted their stories of why they love Augusta. Lauren left thinking about the love for Eatonton – recent survey question resulted in 18% of Eatonton citizens saying they are NOT proud to live in Eatonton.
 - Rebekah stated issues lie with City/County division: Lake People/Farmers/Downtown-City People. We need to find a way to bring them together.
 - 31024 merch/sway is helpful
 - Rebekah suggested a 30124 Car Decal campaign/raffle. Someone is selected/spotted with a 31024 Car Decal and wins a gift card to a downtown business (i.e. El Cazador, Maggie Lane, etc.)
 - Keep thinking about what we can do to bring the “love” to Eatonton.
