


2023 Main Street Survey Results from the Downtown Business Owners


Survey Background:

 - 13 responses were received in 2020.


How long has your business been open in Eatonton/Putnam County?




Do you own or lease your space?

Do you plan to make any of the following investments or improvements in the next 2-3 years?











"I'm not sure what the Main Street program is about, and I would like to learn more about it."










What forms of advertising did you use in 2022?




Which Main Street sponsored events would you to see like to take place in 2024?




Would you like all of Eatonton Main Street's events to take place on the Courthouse Lawn instead of the City Center Stage?



How would you describe the general business climate of Downtown Eatonton over the past 3 years?





How would you rate your overall satisfaction with Downtown Eatonton as a place for doing business?




